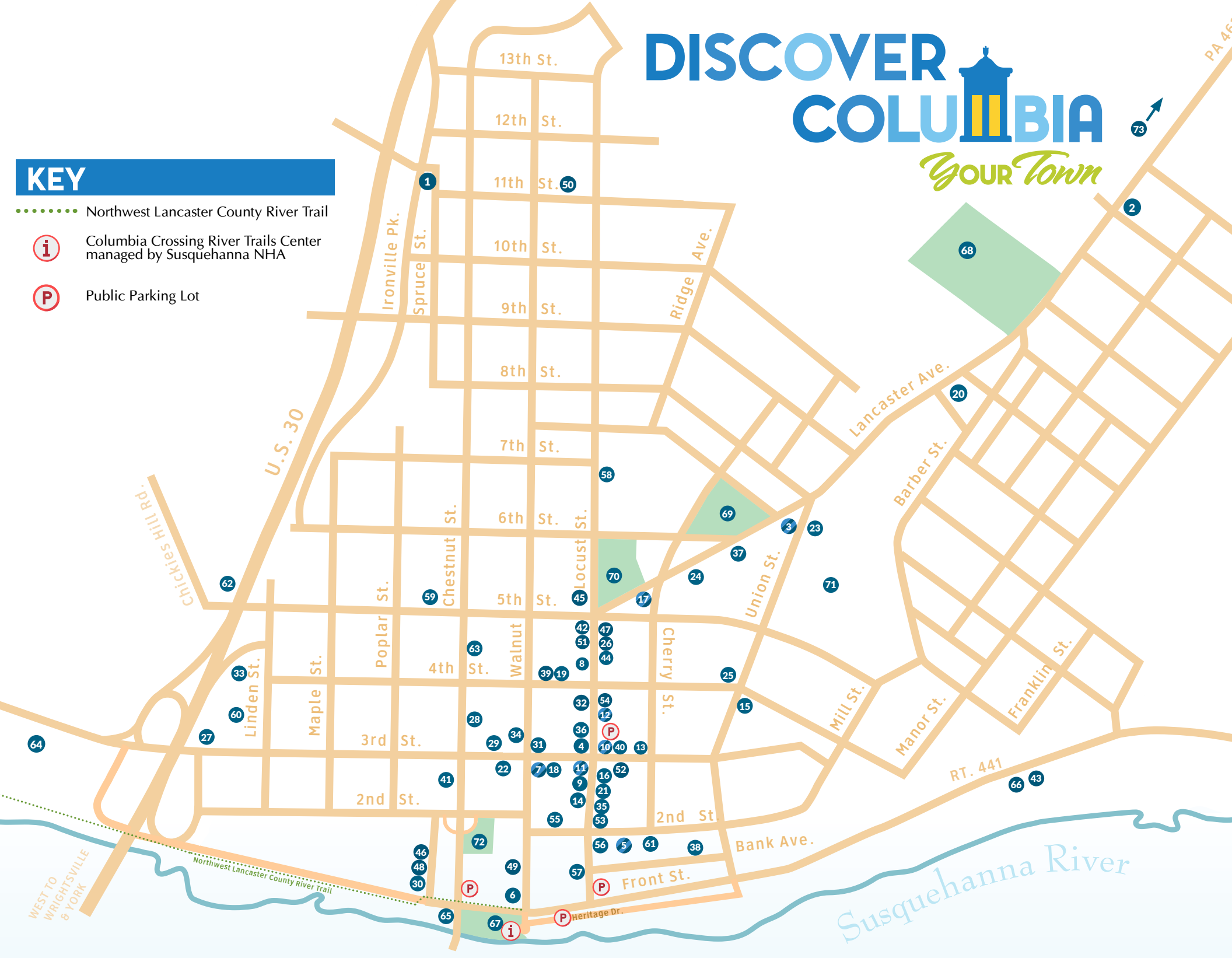

Today, Columbia is a town on the rise. Outdoor recreation along the Susquehanna River has become a strong economic driver for prosperity. Conservation efforts have converted this industrial, polluted river into a natural haven for humans and animals. Our downtown thrives with handmade goods, local antiques, and delectable food.



When you look around Columbia, you'll find almost every aspect of our great nation's history. Columbia - or Wright's Ferry, as it was known in the 17th & 18th centuries - was a gateway to the wilderness. Preceding the Civil War, our town was a hotbed of Underground Railroad activity. Strong Union sentiment protected the town when residents burned the wooden covered bridge to stop Confederate forces. Later industrialization, Prohibition, and the Civil Rights Movement gave unique contributions to the little town of Columbia.
