- 3. Create magical memories on a half-mile hike through almost 600,000 twinkling lights at Christmas Magic A Festival of Lights in Rocky Ridge York County Park.
- 4. Drive through the Christmas Spirit Light Show at Clipper Magazine Stadium in Lancaster.
- 5. Santa Claus is coming to town! Take the whole family to visit Santa at various locations throughout Lancaster and York Counties.
- 6. All Aboard! Ride the Christmas City Express at the Ma & Pa Railroad in Muddy Creek Forks!
- 7. Enjoy a Holiday Show at the Fulton Opera House, Susquehanna Stage Company, Dutch Apple Dinner Theater in Lancaster County, or the Appel Center for the Arts in York County.
- 8. Celebrate Yuletide traditions at President James Buchanan's Wheatland or Historic Rock Ford this holiday to uncover what this festive time of year was like in early America.
- 9. Go on an epic winter adventure! Zipline through Christmas lights at Refreshing Mountain Retreat, enjoy the slopes at Ski Round Top, or go sledding at York Heritage Hills Hotel.
- 10. The next stop is the Ed King Memorial Model Train Open House at the Columbia Historic Preservation Society or Home for the Holidays at the Railroad Museum of Pennsylvania.

- 20. Get holly-jolly with Holiday Cheers at Nissley Vineyards & Winery Estate or sip wine in a cozy outdoor igloo at Moon Dancer Winery.
- 21. Deck the halls with boughs of holly! Visit a Christmas tree farm for all your natural decorative holiday trimmings or join SNHA for Natural Ornament Making on December 9th.
