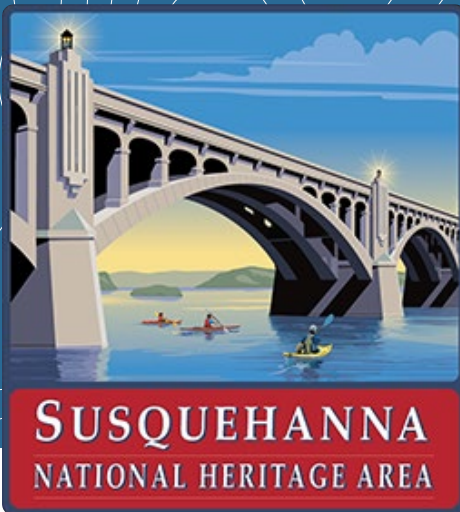

Susquehanna National Heritage Area (SNHA) is developing the historic Mifflin House & Farm into the Susquehanna Discovery Center & Heritage Park. Envisioned as a world-class destination, the site is a noted station on the Underground Railroad as well as was central to the Civil War fighting in Wrightsville. The site will also house a River Art Museum showcasing over 400 years of Susquehanna River art. The surrounding 79-acre Heritage Park will provide passive recreational opportunities. This project offers a unique opportunity to embrace historic preservation, inclusive storytelling, economic development, outdoor recreation, land conservation, and watershed protection into a cohesive experience.
